



# Spelling words with a-y

We know that we *often* spell the long a sound with a-i, but when the long a sound comes at the ENDS of words, it's not an a-i that says /ay/,  
it's a-y!

Remember that compound words (two words together that make a new word) can have a-y within words, such as daytime and playmate.
